Career training programs vary among the different Job Corps Centers.



Earn industry-recognized credentials from organizations such as the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER). Students who train in union-affiliated and national-contracted programs, such as the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America (UBCJA), International Masonry Institute (IMI), International Union of Operating Engineers (IUOE), International Union of Painters and Allied Trades (IUPAT), National Plastering Industry's Joint Apprenticeship Trust Fund (NPIJATF), and Home Builders Institute (HBI), can earn a pre-apprentice certificate of completion that offers apprenticeship opportunities and on-the-job experience.

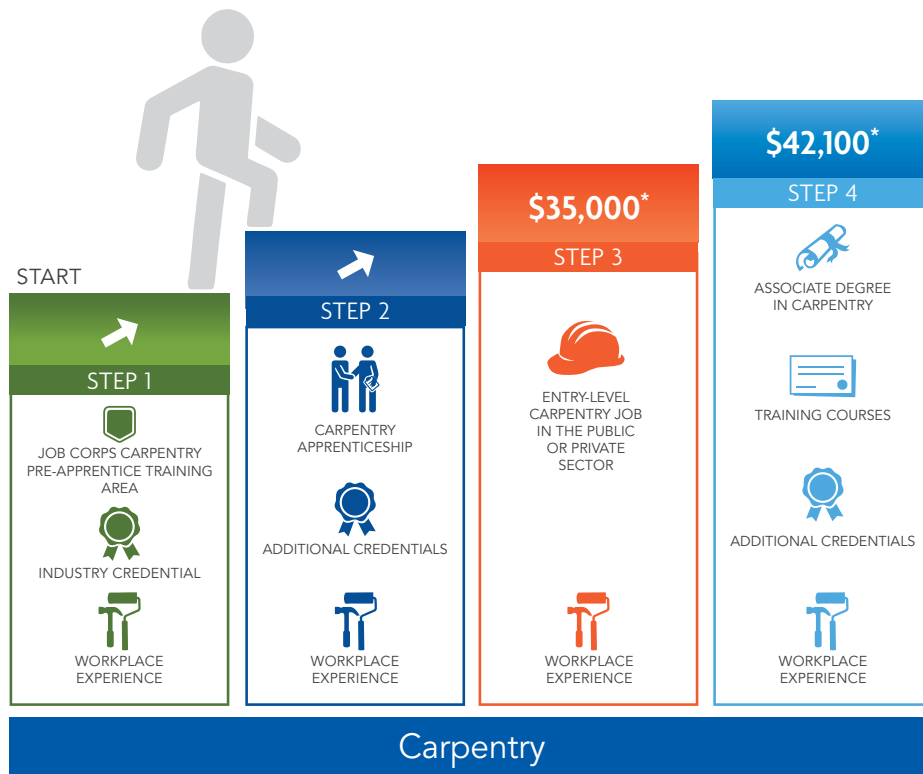


Salaries for entry-level jobs in Construction range from \$28,000 to \$49,000.*
